Can DTCC put a note of objection into the council for both planning applications on behalf on the local residents. Reference numbers are 21/02664/FUL 21/03191/FUL. Councillor Barrie very aware – Historic Scotland are very happy with the outcome of the building and the owners have spent a vast amount of money in upgrading the property. Noise concerns are not the issue of planning department – there are legislations in place to deal with these issues should they occur.
