1. Development Plan 2030 – huge emphasis on equality. To be signed off by Scottish Government.

Main Points:

- 35% of social housing over 12 units (increased from 25%)
 - Mobility Plan – how we move around the city – tram network, changing bus routes to meet demand.
 - 20 minute neighbourhoods (never 20 minutes away on foot or bike from daily amenities, or 20 minutes by bus from amenities not as frequently accessed e.g. hospitals).
 - Dealing with issues on climate change – planting, forestry etc
2. Skips, litter day – engage with community on Facebook regarding their opinions. Potential for community grant funding. Where should the skip be located?
 3. Councillors Report – Fly tipping complaints, look at ideas to positively encourage and engage younger people in the community.
